Please see below for this week's Last Chance Animals list. As a reminder, **all official requests need to be submitted by 6 a.m. next Wednesday.** Below are the descriptions of the animals included on the LCA list. All the animals' observation and medical notes have also been included in an attachment for your convenience.

ALL inquiries and requests regarding animals on the LCA list MUST be communicated to Animal Services through the Rescue.Coordinator@ocfl.net email address within the timeframe indicated. Failure to do so may result in a delay and failure of your message to reach the appropriate individuals at Animal Services.

Communication must be from the rescue's registered contacts.

Animal Services will not liaise with unauthorized personnel on behalf of the rescue.

Please understand we will not be able to offer extensions for any of these pets and the deadline to receive placement is firm.

To help offset the cost of care, Orange County Animal Services is offering rescue partners a \$100 incentive per dog for accepting any of the dogs listed below.

A453294 Chloe –

- First impound 6/5/20
 - Stray
 - Adopted on 6/29/20
- Second impound 5/3/21
 - Surrender: “[Owner] brought in a dog she got from a prev owner back in January of 2021 claiming the dog is highly animal aggressive. [Owner] stated she has tried reaching out to the rescues on OCAS website and was not able to re-home "Chloe" and that in the time she has had the dog she has been re-homed 3x's and all three times the dog has come back for the animal agg. [Owner] informed me "Chloe" has been around male dogs with no issues although she is very high energy and plays rough. Last known bite was over one month ago when she bit a woman who was trying to break up a fight between Chloe and another female dog.” Reached out to adopter, who confirmed they rehomed the dog.
 - Owner opted to reclaim the following day.
- Third impound 8/30/25
 - Stray
 - Owner unable to reclaim, reported: “dog bit the previous owner on the face when she tried to separate the dog from attacking another dog.”
 - Adopted on 3/15/26
- Fourth impound 3/18/26
 - Returned: “[Adopter] stated they were returning the dog due to it being aggressive and "going after" [spouse], attempting to bite his hand. [Adopter] expressed that he didn't feel safe with the dog remaining in his home with his small children.

- Due to urinary issues, dog was radiographed on 4/3/26 with these findings: “

Veterinarian's observations:

-Severe gas distension stomach noted w/ gas distension throughout entire GI. cranial abdomen not visible on images. Due risk bloating PE +/- repeat imaging requested.

-Suspect ingesta stomach w/ moderate distension. Incidental microchip on repeat imaging great improvement gas distension noted in stomach & GI tract. Reported to be housetrained . Minor pressure caudal abdomen noted elicit immediate urination. No visible c/s bloating on PE. Panting w/ limping (R) hind (pv noted stifle dz (R) hind). Unable perform UA in facility. Requested CBC/Chem.

-Schedule daily high priority TE to take out to urinate/defecate 2-3 times a day & feed 2-3 time for next 7 days.

- Chloe is easily excited, gulps air, resulting in concern for bloat. Needs to remain in clinic housing to limit stress/excitement.
- Behaviorally Chloe does well in the shelter environment, and can selectively be paired with other dogs. Behavior reported by owners presents concern.

- Available for both rescue placement and adoption.

A541655 Sadie –

- Impounded 12/23/25
 - Confiscated due to housing not in compliance with Orange County Code, emaciated, owner in the process of being evicted, could not provide proper care.
- HW(+), has sponsorship.
- Chloe has improved medically but given the long stay in shelter (4 months), she is declining behaviorally and mentally, showing signs of stress and anxiety. Given this deterioration, she cannot remain in the shelter long-term.
- Information has been previously shared to all rescue partners, with no interest thus far.
- Available for both rescue placement and adoption.

A588245 Forest –

- First impound 1/14/26
 - Stray

- Forest has shown mouthy behaviors. He has snapped at staff members, once related to a food bowl and another time redirecting aggression during a fight with another dog. He is selective with other dogs.
- The decline in behavior seems indicative of mental deterioration and he currently poses a bite risk to handlers.

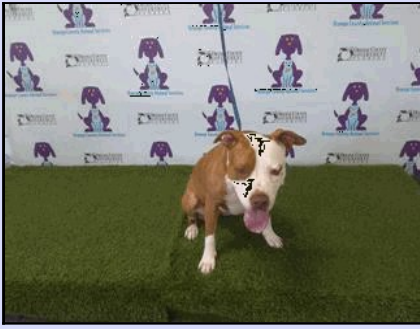

THE DOG HAD A BAD EAR INFECTION IN THE RIGHT EAR. THERE WAS DARK COLORED FLUID AND SOME BLOODY PUSS IN THE EAR; DOG ALSO UNDERWEIGHT AND HAS A MASS ON THE BELLY. SET UP FOR A VET EXAM."

In the yard, A453294 ran around and dispelled energy. A453294 was very food motivated, but did take treats roughly. A453294 was high energy and continued to display stress signals in the yard, but remained playful and social, allowing full handling. Already on Project Pets. Currently paired and doing well. Keep on Advanced due to sheer size/strength. Would benefit from foster, rescue, and/or social push due to length of stay and display of slight mental/behavioral decline in kennel.

A453294 was very pushy and demanding with treats, every so often height-seeking and jumping at treat pouch. 175 practiced rewarding for good behavior and would only give her a treat when she default sat (palm up or toss; she takes treats roughly). Another dog came by the yard and A453294 began showing concerning levels of reactivity (potential barrier/fence reactivity?).
