Below are the descriptions of the animals included on the LCA list. All the animals' observation and medical notes have also been included in an attachment for your convenience.

Failure to do so may result in a delay and failure of your message to reach the appropriate individuals at Animal Services.

Communication must be from the rescue's registered contacts.

Animal Services will not liaise with unauthorized personnel on behalf of the rescue.

Please understand we will not be able to offer extensions for any of these pets and the deadline to receive placement is firm.

ABC 180 and 181 took out A507023 for an assessment. A507023 was easily leashed, but immediately upon exiting kennel became very reactive towards the dogs in neighboring kennels. A507023 was pulling and lunging at every kennel. Once in the yard, A507023 sought social with both handlers and showed no reactivity. A507023 was similarly difficult to put back in her kennel because of reactivity towards other dogs. No redirection towards handlers was shown.

Recommendation: Advanced handler. Keep as single dog only.

Dog easily leashed and walke dout. Food resource guarding evaluation: no aggression displayed. No interest in toy. Dog/dog with 508062 who was calm avoidant. 023 at first stiffened via fence then calmed. In yard intrusive to approach but breaking focus, long sniffs then would walk away. 062 avoidant for the first few minutes then sniffed 023 appropriately and walked away at which point 023 fixated with hard focus tense muzzle and lip licking began to mount, was pulled off due to level of arousal observed. Handlers did not allow 023 to mount though she attempted again within a few seconds with same tensing of body language, highly dominant behavior began once 062 sniffed (appropriately). 023 is highly social seeking with people and per previous adopter did good with the kids/adults in the home but presented aggressive behavior around their other dog. Based on previous adopter history and observed behavior today, recommending dog is moved to general as single dog only with assistance required and behavior waiver req'd.

In the play yard, A565608 sought social but also seemed less energetic than normal. A565608 had bloody stool. 180 went to grab the leash to bring A565608 back to her kennel, and she began height seeking and biting at the leash and 180's arms and hands. A565608 was brought back to the kennel and unleashed without incident. Recommendation: Keep on Staff Assist.

ABC 175 and 174 pulled A565608 for assessment. A565608 was very overstimulated in the kennel and showing high stress/anxiety (heavy panting, pacing, jumping). A565608 allowed leashing easily and came out of the kennel in a rush. A565608 did rush towards 175 and hyperfixated on the leash that 175 was holding. 174 held her back and she turned and began biting the leash that 174 was holding. A565608 continued to jump and height-seek at the leash. Handlers hurried down hallway and once away and at the back of the kennels, A565608 continued to play tug but was able to be distracted by treats. In yard, A565608 calmed down and seeked social with 175. A565608 leaned against handler and allowed full handling. A565608 did have intermittent moments of overstimulation where she would begin to height-seek the leash again or height-seek at handlers. 175 would correct to which A565608 listened. When placing back, A565608 did rush the kennels but did not bite at the leash.

Recommendation: A565608 seems to be beginning to mentally decline due to pent up frustration/stress. Needs placement.

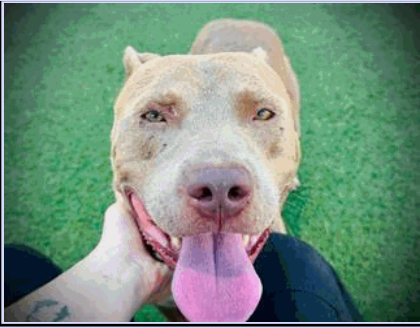
